Conference location

Chisinau is the capital of Moldova. It is the largest city of the country and its political, administrative, economical, cultural centre and is considered to be one of the greenest cities in Europe. As the most economically and socially important municipality in Moldova, the city has a broad range of educational facilities.

One of most important higher technical educational institution is Technical University of Moldova, founded in 1964, under the name "The Polytechnic Institute of Chişinău," as a center for engineering and economic specialties from the Moldova State University.

The university had begun with 5140 students and 278 teachers within 5 faculties: Electrotechnics, Mechanics, Technology, Construction and Economy. Since 1964, the university has grown extensively, producing 66,000 specialists and becoming an important educational, scientific and cultural center.
